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
Adults with Complex Communication Needs

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Key literacy skills and activities

- Reading to student & talking about texts
- Phonological awareness skills
- Letter-sound correspondences
- Sight word recognition skills
- Decoding skills
- Shared reading
- Reading and understanding books / other texts
- Early writing skills

- Make instruction meaningful
- Modify the activity to support participation
- Provide effective instruction
- Ensure multiple opportunities to practice skills





Checklist for effective literacy instruction

☐ Make

- Target important literacy skills
- instruction meaningful
- Use motivating words & topics
- Make connections to personal experiences

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☐ Modify the activity to support participation	 Utilize familiar content /task formats Provide pictures or signs as response options Select foils carefully Provide oral scaffolding support as required 	
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☐Ensure multiple opportunities to practice skills	 Provide instruction at least 3-5 /week Practice skills in meaningful activities Provide 10 or more opportunities to practice each skill in an activity

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☐ Modify the activity to support participation	 Utilize familiar content /task formats Provide pictures or signs as response options Select foils carefully Provide oral scaffolding support as required
☐ Provide effective instruction	 Model task Provide guided practice to promote success/ minimize error Provide feedback on responses Promote independence by fading support
☐ Ensure multiple opportunities to practice skills	Provide focused instruction at least 3-5 times per week Practice new skills and review previously learned skills in meaningful activities Provide 10 or more opportunities to practice each skill
