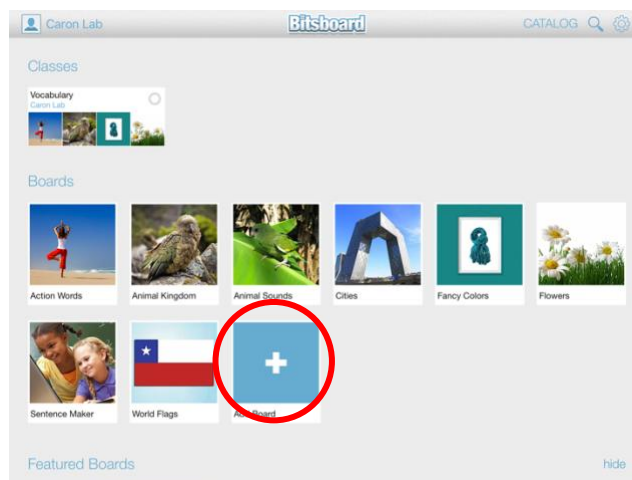


App Tutorial Bitsboard Pro


1. Open **Bitsboard Pro**. The icon for Bitsboard is shown below!



2. Click on your **user** to get to the home page. If you do not have a user click **add user** to create a new user or add a preexisting user to the device. It will prompt you to create a username, login with an existing user, or login with Facebook. If you create a new account you just need to create a user name. Adding an email and a password to the account is optional.
3. You are now on the home page. To add a new board click the **add board** button. You can select to download a board, import a board from drop box, import a board from quizlet, combine or copy a board, or to create a new board. If you hit create a new board it will prompt you to name the new board.


