


Q1 - Did you feel it was beneficial for your organization to attend Education Career Day?










Q3 - Estimate the number of students you met with at the fair.

Q4 - Estimate the number of resumes collected during the fair.







Q5 - How many second, on-site interviews do you anticipate with Penn State students?

Q2 - Overall, how would you rate the fair?





Please give feedback on this years' Education Career Day fair.

Overall, we wonder if students pursuing a career in K-12 education are up to date on the variety of educational offerings there are in public education today. A number of students we spoke with had no knowledge of the existence of cyber education at all and other students we spoke with had not researched us to know we were grades 6-12 only). We see this as an opportunity for 21CCCS to work with PSU to ensure that graduating students are aware of the different employment opportunities available to them at graduation. We have employed PSU graduates over the years and some of our most successful teachers have come from your program! As the top cyber school in the state ranked 32 out of 647 schools in PA for SAT scores (and a Top Workplace award winner for both 2016 and 2017), we feel we have a lot to offer both new graduates and seasoned teachers alike. We welcome the opportunity to showcase our innovative working environment to your students.

The tables were very crowded so it was hard when we had a lot of students talking to us at once. Also, by the time the fair ended and we got down to lunch it did not leave us a lot of time to eat before we had to be back up there ready for interviews.

Corner spots really created a crowded environment for both the corner and the tables next to it.

The only disappointment was the decline in the number of teacher candidates. This has been symptomatic of all the job fairs we have attended this year - they just aren't out there like they used to be.

It has been a number of years since Central Bucks School District has attended the Education Career Day fair at PSU. It was very beneficial and we will be attending future career day events at PSU.

Well organized and very accommodating.

The candidates we interviewed were very well prepared and demonstrated a level of instructional knowledge exceeding that of many new teachers. We certainly would have liked to talk to/interview more candidates.

Quantity of candidates visiting my booth was up. The quality has always been there.

Overall, the Penn State Career Day fair was a very good day. Having a 30 minute lunch when interviews were not supposed to be scheduled was helpful. I thought the fair was well run and I enjoyed it.

We had feedback from a student who said we were not noted as needing elementary teachers which was not accurate and we are not sure where this came from. We did not get many secondary teacher candidates stop by which was disappointing. Also, having water nearby would be great.

As an out of state system that only sent one representative, my role for the day was to meet and greet candidates. Collect resumes and review for possible employment. The frustrating part was there was a long line waiting for a PA district, that admittingly will not hire many. The students need to be coached that extending themselves and simply exchanging a resume will land them an interview for a full-time position. As a building administrator, I stood and watched people walk by. I will hire this next school year no less than 5 teachers. Two Kindergarten and one First grade as well as two Special Education high needs classroom teachers. Of the 8 students who stopped by to see me, 6 will be offered an opportunity to interview for a full-time position. You have some great candidates, I hope they find full-time positions in PA, or they missed an opportunity.

The staff, facility, organization and students are outstanding! It is my favorite recruiting event at a college of all on the schedule.

Very well prepared Special Education grads but very few secondary candidates. Saw great candidates from surrounding college as well.

The fair was very well organized. The participants were professionally dressed, were well-prepared, well-spoken and took initiative. Many of the districts conducting interviews went over the thirty minutes which made it difficult to keep on track with interviews. Perhaps reminders to everyone to please stay within the time frame would help; although, I realize that is not something that can be regulated. Overall, I was very impressed and we will be sending a team again in the future.

This was my first time attending the job fair and I was very impressed with everything. I would think there might be an advantage to grouping some of schools together by geographic location.

We had a great day and appreciate your support! Your staff was readily available to assist with any needs that we had. VERY FEW secondary candidates, particularly in critical need areas, but overall we met only a handful of secondary. Really missed having name tags - it is much more personable to greet candidates by name. Toward the end of the interview time in the main room, some other School Division recruiters were so loud, it was hard to hear the candidate I was interviewing. This was not a problem during the rest of the day. THANK YOU!

The Penn State fair is one that we rely on to speak with large numbers of teacher candidates. This year's May graduates were certainly prepared, but districts like ours need to see more Special Education, ELL, Chemistry, Science, Math, and Spanish certifications. I will also need to start looking for those students who are planning on, or who have obtained the STEM/STEAM cert. Of course, those who have a passion for, or who have had experiences in urban education environments are always high on our list.

We were very disappointed with the amount of secondary certified students. We had several positions that we posted including 2 English, 2 PE/Health, 1 Art, 1 School Counselor, 2 Biology, 1 Learning Support and only had about 10-12 applicants stop by or booth. Also, we were disappointed that there were very few special education applicants. We are seeing at most other PA job fairs, most of the elementary PreK-4 are also special ed certified Pk-8, but that was not the case at PSU. They were all just Pk-4 plus I don't think we had any secondary special education applicants. Most were willing to relocate to South Central PA which was nice and we had a line the entire time for elementary. Other than that, we were pleased with the applicant pool and their professionalism. Also the staff working the fair were polite and helpful.

The last time I visited, candidates were released in a more mainstreamed fashion. The release of candidates at the beginning was more than we could actually handle.

This was my first time at this event, and was impressed with the turn-out! It was run very well, and well-attended. I will definitely return in the future for sure. **Minor feedback, nothing serious, was only that the after-event lunch didn't' start until 12:30--which was 30 minutes after the event ended. In my case, I was commuting 4 hours home so left at 12:00 --just didn't' make sense to lose 30 minutes of time to get a free lunch. **I am sure that worked fine for anyone who planned to stay the night, but I'll bet any of the "commuters" just hit the road rather than wait around.

**BUT these events are NOT about lunches...and so I still give 5 Starts (out of 5 stars) for the event! :-) Thank you, see you next year!



At check-in, I did not receive the materials that other recruiters received. It was very disorganized!!!


