This award recognizes a staff member (full-time/approved reduced schedule under HR105 full-time staff or technical service employees) who exemplifies the following criteria:

1. Exhibits creativity, innovation, and initiative.
2. Demonstrates the ability to mentor, inspire, motivate, and support others.
3. Promotes excellence in teamwork, performance, and achievement within the unit and/or the organization.
4. Demonstrates commitment to and support of University values, including integrity, respect, responsibility, discovery, excellence and community.

Nominations should reflect the current semester.

Eligibility:

- Nominee must be a College of Engineering employee.
- Nominee may be a full-time staff (defined above) or technical service employee with a least 1 year of employment.
- Nominee must be in good standing, defined as: "For University activities such as commissions and award programs, a faculty or staff member is considered to be in 'good standing' if the individual is meeting the expectations of his/her position and has not been the recipient of recent discipline. The individual should also exhibit qualities such as civility, collegiality, and a commitment to the overall success of his/her department."
- Nominee must not have received this award in the past 3 years.

Award: The award recipient will receive a \$99.99 gift card and be recognized in the SAC quarterly newsletter and at the College of Engineering Annual Awards event.
