Deadlines

- **Fall** semester – Application due **July 1st**
- **Spring** semester – Application due **November 1st**
- **Summer** semester – Application due **April 1st**

When:

- Your internship is the final requirement that must be completed before graduation. All RHS coursework for must be completed before scheduling your internship in your final semester.

Length:

- Fall and Spring internships require 525 hours (15 weeks)
- Summer internships require 520 hours (13 weeks)
