- 2. Growing to reach your maximum potential
- 3. Sowing seeds to benefit others

"Everyone's responsibility is to IDENTIFY that purpose"

Total buy-in of the Leaders vision is ESSENTIAL for Success

Mike Morse – Foundation

- 6 Qualities of A Great Coach Foundation
- 1. Values "do your values reflect the organizations / institutions values?"
- 2. Reading People "understanding the motives of people helps you read them"
- **3.** Basis of Power "figure out who really has the power who is really running the show"
- **4. Composure** "you will need to have it"
- 5. Goals "remain focused on your goals"
- 6. Attitude "challenges don't define you, your response to those challenges define you"

Mike Morse - Adversity

- **Stockdale Paradox** *Jim Stockdale was a prisoner of war (POW) survivor for 7 years in Vietnam tortured over 20 times*
- **Question to him –** who did **NOT** get out **NOT** survive?
- **His Answer –** *"the optimist…* You must retain faith that you will prevail in the end, regardless of the difficulties. AND at the same time…You must confront the most brutal facts of your current reality, whatever they might be."
- 3 Points to Leadership (Contingency Planning)
- 1. What is the reality of your situation? *(Reality)*
- 2. Develop a plan for that reality (Confront that Reality)
- 3. Stay the course keep faith that you will prevail *(Faith)*

"Make a commitment to REALITY"

Mike Morse – 5 Levels of Leadership

- Level 1 Positional
- Level 2 Permission
- Level 3 Production
- Level 4 People Development
- Level 5 Personhood

- UPS rule must have driven the truck to lead


