- Synchronous final exams have to be scheduled at the regular scheduled time.
- Hybrid summer courses are still coded as "remote."
- Academic Integrity cases have increased.
- Make sure changes to course are documented in syllabus and clearly communicated to students.
- Contact Bookstore manager Tom Fankhauser for information about mailing options for student course materials.
 - o Contacting earlier is better; may be a delay due to demand
