My Dear Mr. Eiche,
I arrived home on a redeployment-recuperation furlough in
time to receive your letter requesting

information about me.

I was overseas nine months. I saw most of Europe including France, Germany, Italy, Austria, Czechoslovakia, Holland, Belgium and Luxemburg. I saw action with the seventh army as we crossed the Rhine river at Mannheim. I was awarded a purple-heart after the battle of the Rhineland. On June 26, 1945, I arrived in the United States, and received a thirty-one day furlough.

I am expecting to see duty in C.B.I. within the next six months. After this furlough I shall return to Ft. Jackson, South Carolina.
