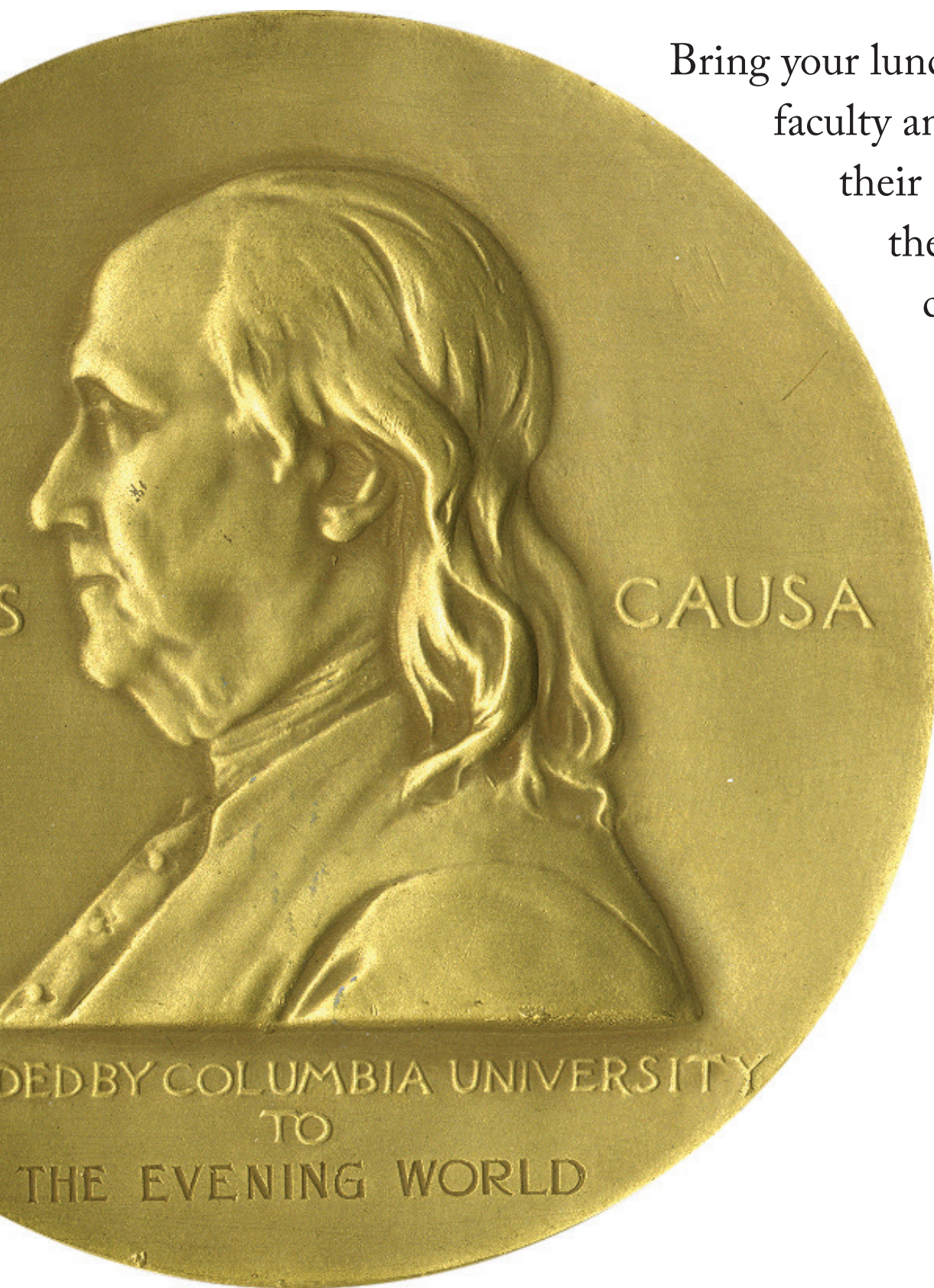


Learn at Lunch
