- Survey with committee on how things have been going
- One negative situation each with staff & faculty, but none with students
- More clarification, HR policy...
- Will be getting resources from UP
- Surprisingly effective- keep doing what we're doing
- Committee will meet once this Fall and then again in Spring
- Look into students covertly vaping where they shouldn't be...
- Also trash in parking lots needs to be disposed properly

University Faculty Senator's Report: Nothing to report because meeting is coming up soon

Athletic Department Report: Staci Brennan

- Report from Spring semester (see posted PPT slides)
- Part I: Team GPA Past 2 Years, highlighting means GPA improved from previous year (only Wrestling team did not improve)
- Part II: Dean's list student athlete numbers 42/109 & Semester GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Part III: Academically Ineligible Student Athletes -> low numbers 1 after Fa17, 8 after Sp18 (2 did what was necessary over the summer to become eligible again)
- Faculty concern: coaches want student athletes not to schedule courses during certain times, but coaches need to know that some courses are only offered at those times
- Students might be intimidated by their coaches, so some schedule courses and then don't attend.
- This weekend: Pink out weekend: soccer & volleyball

Committee Reports:

- Athletics Report: Kendra Sites, Chair of Faculty Athletic Committee (see posted PPT slides)
- Every semester: Faculty Notification Form, Class Excuse Form (with schedule on the back)
 - Encourage faculty to cross-check schedule for class conflicts

- Help & Support: Athletic Director, Academic Coach (Dr. Tucker), CARE Team
 - Dr. Tucker meeting with roughly half the student athletes for study halls
 - Communication is Key -> *Please fill out Starfish midterm surveys!*
- Class attendance policy: E-11 (http://undergrad.psu.edu/aappm/E-11-class-attendance.html)
 - Supposed to inform in advance when possible (initial schedule) strongly encouraged to give reminders as well
 - Student's responsibility to complete work in advance
 - Instructor should provide students, within reason, the opportunity to make up missed work
 - Not all work can be made-up
 - Maybe this is not the semester to take this particular class...
 - False claims of legitimate absence may be considered academic integrity violations
- IT Report: Robin Yaure (see posted slides)
- Helping with transition to Office 365
 - Early adopters (IT committee & staff in Perry House) -> pretty smooth transition
- Preparing for semester imaging of classroom/lab computers
 - Often appears to be a seamless process, but we should be aware of what software we use
- Can we have an intranet in addition to website (like Abington)?
 - For PDFs that are not accessible to screen readers?
 - Are PDFs allowed on an intranet?
 - Sites pages do not have specific rules, but still need to be cautious about disabilities
 - Canvas: new IT module, but Staff can't access that...
- IT capacity for classrooms is problematic: Running out of computer lab classrooms
 - Nursing requires students to bring in a laptop
 - Kudos to the IT dept for helping with the exams!
- Communications between IT & faculty
 - Is there a better way to contact faculty than e-mails?
- Instructional designer at MA?
- Ideas for MADE: learning about Office 365 apps
- Report at each MAFS meeting, with possibly a 2-3 minute demo
- Survey of faculty needs from IT committee
- Notes on podia: what to do if you have a problem and need help...
- Possibly Zooming MAFS meetings (for long distance participation)
