2019-20 University Budget Update – BOT

July 2019 Board of Trustees meeting:

- ✓ approved 0% tuition increase for PA residents
- √ approved 2.5% general salary increase pool
- √ immediate \$36M deficit



2019-20 University Budget Update – Projected Deficit

- \$36M funding sources planned expenditures
- + 9M use of reserves
- + 11M recycling (1% from units)
- \$16M funding sources planned expenditures

2019-20 OVPCC Budget Update – Projected Deficit

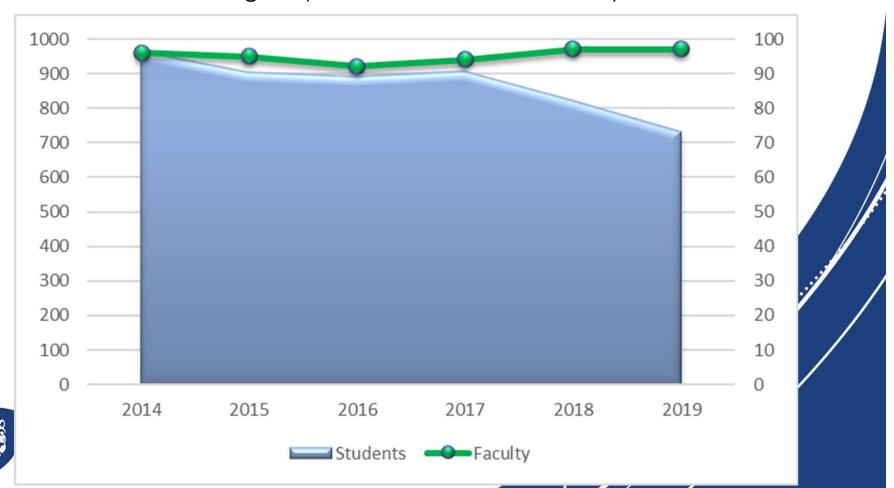
- \$39M funding sources planned expenditures

- + 10M Provost support

- \$8M funding sources planned expenditures



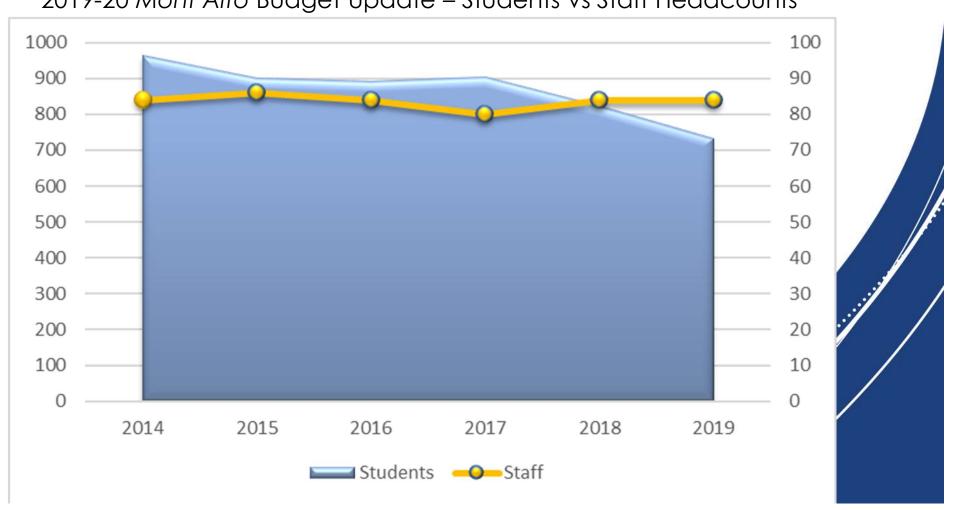

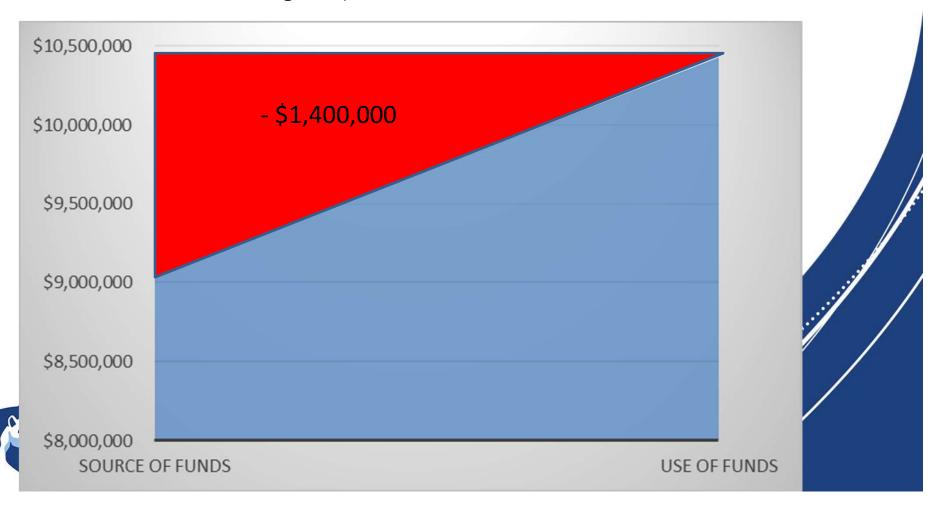
2019-20 Mont Alto Budget Update – Students vs Faculty Headcounts



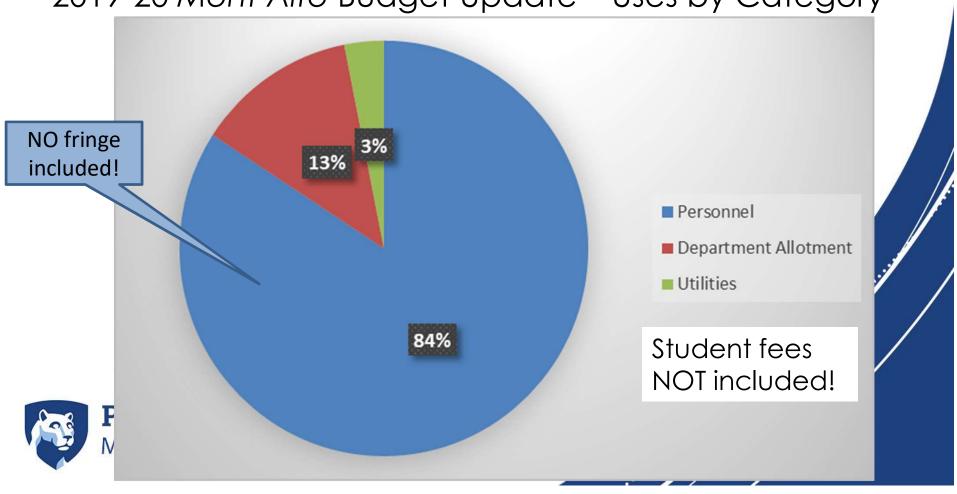
2019-20 Mont Alto Budget Update – Students vs Staff Headcounts



2019-20 Mont Alto Budget Update – Sources vs Uses of Funds



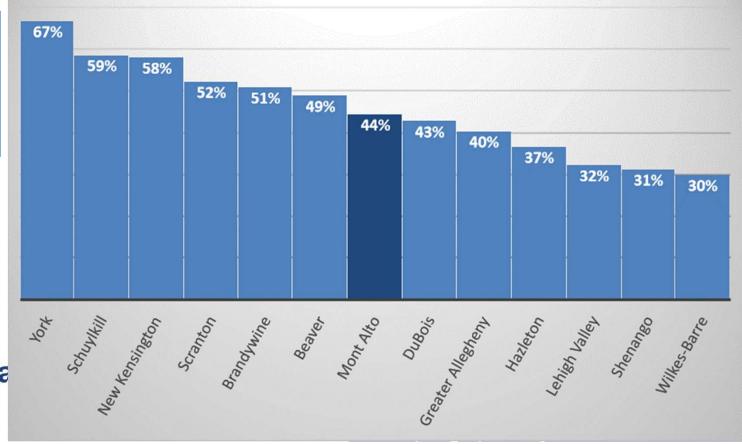
2019-20 Mont Alto Budget Update – Uses by Category

To close budget gap:

- √ 15% Dept Allotment recycling
- ✓ Institute hiring freeze effective immediately (exception: new approved programs or mission critical positions)
- ✓ Institute sabbatical leave freeze



2019-20 Mont Alto Budget Update – Action Items

- ✓ Implement student recruitment and retention initiatives.
- ✓ Increase class sizes where appropriate (decrease FT2s, SUPPs)
- ✓ Limit employee travel to required/mission-critical only
- ✓ Optimize procurement processes
- ✓ Complete staffing analysis relative to comparable campuses
- ✓ Maximize Student Aid availability (scholarship/gift funds)
- ✓ Increase CE revenues
