- Mont Alto Faculty Senate Executive Board (need to elect 3) -- only 2 so far

Peter Dendle & Kira Hamman **need more names**

A secret ranked choice ballot listing all nominees is distributed to the general membership. New officers are chosen by a Borda count of the ranked choice ballots. The candidate with the highest Borda count total will serve as Chair-elect.

- University College Faculty Council (need to elect 1) 2 names on the ballot so far Somjit & Hanafiah.
- University Senator no election this year.
