Highlights of Admin Review process (Oct - Dec 2019)

Met with Dr. Hanes in January and also on campus end of February with Nick Jones

No broad dissemination of results for DAA (only Chancellor review; that's normal)

35 faculty filled out the survey (out of 59)

Mike: overall = 69% ratings as excellent, 13% good, 15% average, 3% poor

Strengths: 1. Approachable, shows empathy, listens well; 2. Supports faculty & staff, assists effectively with P & T; 3. Student centered

Areas for Growth: 1. Dealing with conflict & difficult people; 2. Follow through;

3. Faculty oversight: discussion of goals at FAR meetings

& hiring part-time faculty when full-time don't have a full load

Recommendations: Conflict resolution training; Hold faculty accountable for syllabi, committee work, office hours; Review of part-time faculty

Mike put together an action plan with strategies he will employ:

Supervision series & some trainings (success skills for supervisors, accountable leadership, leadership foundations)

Chancellor & CAO of Fayette, Dr. A's successor at Fayette, has agreed to Mike's request to serve as his executive coach

Working with MAFS Exec committee: faculty office hours, faculty presence on campus...

Revising FAR meetings and review letters (to give summative and formative feedback & suggestions on goals)

Follow through: making appropriate decisions and communicating with those involved (involving HR Consultant where HR issues are raised)

Summary: Positive review, Good action plan

More limited 360 degree review (campus only) follow up in Fall 2020
