1. Call to Order and opening remarks

- 2. Teaching Line Promotion Guidelines

 - It could be helpful to add a librarian to the group for additional expertise on information management.
- 5. Miscellaneous
 - Campus police will start wearing body cameras.
 - Limiting opening discussions of MAFS meetings to 5 minutes has been helpful and successful so far.
 - Mike will discuss access to campus at beginning of the semester, the COVID testing process for students, and the exception process for in-person courses for the January 19th start date at the next MAFS meeting.
 - Peter will reach out to invite Sonja Loewe to MAFS meetings for updates for continued updates.
 - Courtney Gotham may also want to provide updates on campus messaging.
 - Faculty might be interested in hearing from Shawn Wiley about admissions updates.

- Kira will mention race, equity, and action programming and specific details related to this, along with a reminder about the multicultural seminars offered on campus.
- Robin will briefly address the importance of using Starfish to communicate with faculty about the importance of putting notes into the system.
