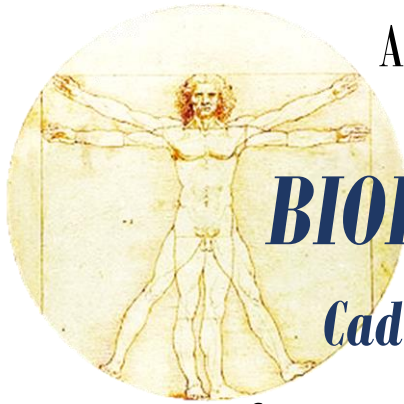

***Cadavers, Culture, and Science (3 Credits)***

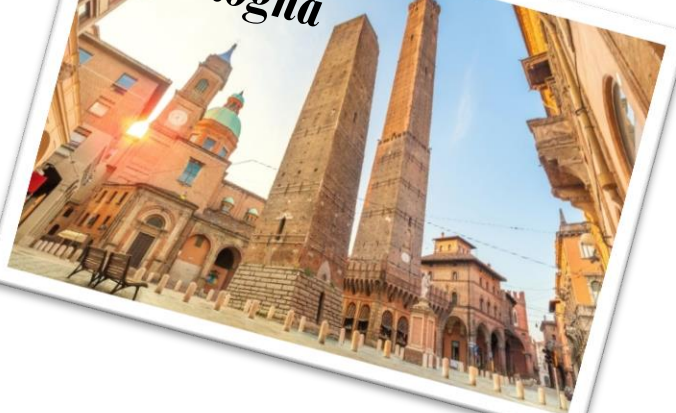
**A fascinating blend of Biology and History, investigating the evolution of anatomy and physiology in Renaissance Italy**
