SARA - PA State Portal Entity - Brief History

- Act 35 of 2016 was passed by the General Assembly and signed by Governor Tom Wolf on June 1, 2016
- The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) joined SARA in Fall 2016 and was designated by Act 35 as the SARA State Portal Entity
- In order to be a State participating in SARA, the state must belong to or be affiliated with a regional compact
- Pennsylvania is affiliated with the Southern Regional Educational Board (SREB)

SARA - Annual Institutional Renewal

- Institutions must renew annually
- Institutions receive a renewal reminder
- PA institutions must submit two forms:
 - Institutional Renewal Application, including required documents
 - The PA Supplement
- Completed forms and all documents are emailed to giwetten@pa.gov



SARA - Annual Institutional Fees

Pennsylvania's Fee:

- Original regulation fees sunset in 2018
- Reduced fee schedule is planned to resume in 2023

Distance Tuition Revenue Fee	Proposed New Fee
\$0-9,999	\$1,000
\$10,000-4,999,999	\$2,000
\$5,000,000-19,999,999	\$3,000
\$20,000,000-39,999,999	\$5,000
\$40,000,000 and over	\$7,000



SARA - Annual Institutional Fees

National Council for State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement's Fee (NC-SARA)

After renewal forms and documents have been received and processed by PDE, institutions must pay the NC-SARA fee (this fee has NOT been waived and must be paid annually):

- Institutions will receive an email from NC-SARA
- Institutions must pay the fee before the institution's individual renewal due date



Please ensure within the institutional application that ALL fields are completed and/or initialed, including:

- 1. Catastrophic Events
- 2. Complaint Link
- 3. Professional Licensure Link
- 4. Additional Campus Information

By initialing the application, the institution is ensuring a policy for:

1. Catastrophic Events

- Complete #11 on page 3 and keep a copy at the institution
- Should include safety and emergency plans as we have learned through the COVID-19 pandemic
- This can be requested by the Pennsylvania State Portal Entity at any time for verification purposes



2. Complaint Link

- Located on page 4
- To confirm compliance with 34 CFR§668.43(b) Institutional information:

The institution must make available for review to any enrolled or <u>prospective</u> <u>student</u> upon request, a copy of the documents describing the institution's accreditation and its state, federal, or tribal approval or licensing. The institution must also provide its students or <u>prospective students</u> with contact information for filing complaints with its accreditor and with its state approval or licensing entity and any other relevant state official or agency that would appropriately handle a student's complaint.

The institution must include:

- 3. Professional Licensure Link (Federal Requirement)
 - Include the link where professional licensure disclosures are listed
 - Use additional paper if necessary
- 4. Additional Campus Information
 - Make sure to add any additional campus information
 - Use additional paper if necessary



SARA - PA Requirements for Composite Score Review

Review of Institutional Composite scores in PA

- Score of 1.5 or greater approved
- Score of less than 1.5 for new institutions, is not permitted
- Score between 1.0 and 1.49 renewed on provisional status
- Score below 1.0 removed
- Score is not on the most recent Federal Financial Responsibility
 Composite Score listing (currently published 2018-19) Pennsylvania
 will place the institution on provisional status and the institution must
 provide:
 - The two most recent audited financial statements, including the current year
 - eZ-Audit acknowledgement from United States Department of Education (USDE) showing the current year was submitted and is being reviewed by USDE
