Permissions and Copyright Policies for Center Holdings

For Keystone Folklore Quarterly/Keystone Folklore/Pennsylvania Traditions

The Pennsylvania Center for Folklore (PACF) retains copyright to original text printed in *Keystone Folklore Quarterly/Keystone Folklore/Pennsylvania Traditions*.

Requests for reprinting should include the full citation information for the item being requested for reproduction, as well as information about its prospective use. For books, please include information about the content of the book, the authors/editors, press, the projected cost of the text, and the anticipated print run. Please specify any electronic rights being requested, as well as what kind of copyright statement will be included in the work.

All requests should be emailed to the Center at folklore@psu.edu or mailed to the Center's campus address.

Permission for reprinting may be granted at the discretion of the Center Director in accordance with the following guidelines:

For academic books (publication by university press, non-profit organization, or scholarly imprint with print-runs under 500):

The PACF regularly grants, without charge, permission to reprint articles in limited print-run academic books, contingent upon:

1. The placement of the following acknowledgement in the text: "This article originally appeared as [Citation information to original work]. It is reprinted with permission from the Pennsylvania Center for Folklore at Penn State University (<http://sites.psu.edu/pafolklore>)."
2. Two gratis copies of the final book be sent to the Center.

For course packs

The PACF regularly grants permission for the reprinting of articles in course packs at the following rate:

10 cents a page x the number of copies being produced.

If the instructor who will be assembling and using the course pack is also the author of the requested item, this fee will normally be waived.

For commercial books or high print-run academic texts

The PACF regularly grants permission for commercial books or high print-run academic texts at the following rate:

\$100 flat fee per article.

Reprinting is also contingent upon:

1. The placement of the following acknowledgement in the text: "This article originally appeared as [Citation information to original work]. It is reprinted with permission from the Pennsylvania Center for Folklore at Penn State University (<http://sites.psu.edu/pafolklore>)."
2. Two gratis copies of the final book be sent to the Center.

If the author or editor of the book is also the author of the requested item, this fee can be waived, at the discretion of the Center Director.

For images, documents, AV recordings, or other materials from the PACF Archival Collections

Permission to reproduce materials from the Center's archival collections may be granted at the discretion of the Center Director, so long the Center has the rights to grant such permission, and doing so is consistent with the collection's use guidelines.

If granted, the material may be reproduced contingent upon:

1. The placement of as full citation in the text (including any applicable collection, box, folder information) and the following acknowledgement: "This material is reprinted from the [collection name] with permission from the Pennsylvania Center for Folklore at Penn State University (<http://sites.psu.edu/pafolklore>)."
2. Two gratis copies of the final publication or product be sent to the Center.

If Center personal are required to digitize, photograph, or otherwise copy materials to fulfill a request, the request may be subject to additional processing charges.
