Postdoc Spotlight



I CURRENTLY WORK IN DR ERIKA SAUNDERS' MOOD DISORDERS LAB. I've been at Penn State Hershey since August 10th 2015. My work encompasses both research and clinical responsibilities. My current research focuses on dietary interventions for indivduals diagnosed with Bipolar Disorder. We hypothesize that an intervention diet designed to alter intake of polyunsaturated fatty acids that augments mood stabilizing medications will reduce inflammation; and that the reduction of inflammation will reduce mood variability in bipolar disorder. My research during graduate school focused on depression and value-based decision making. In terms of clinical responsibilities, I work at the Outpatient Psychiatry Clinic at Northeast drive twice a week where I evaluate and treat patients diagnosed with mental health disorders. My expertise lies in cognitive behavioral mode of conceptualization and treatment.

I COMPLETED MY UNDERGRAD B.Sc. AND GRADUATE M.SC DEGREE FROM CALCUTTA UNIVERSITY IN PSYCHOLOGY AND APPLIED PSYCHOLOGY RESPECTIVELY. I completed my M.Phil from Glasgow University, UK under the mentorship of Dr Geoff Scobie. I graduated in 2015 with a PhD in Clinical Psychology from the University of Pennsylvania, under the mentorship of Dr Joseph Kable.

I was born in Middleborough, UK and moved to Kolkata, India, when I was nine. I moved to the USA in 2006. My favorite activities outside work include exploring different cultures through traveling and food. I'm pretty good at cooking regional Indian food but nothing beats my mother and grandmother's home cooked meals! I enjoy watching British crime/mystery series including Sherlock, Happy Valley, The Fall, Midsomer Murders, and Death in Paradise. I loved the first season of True Detective.

While filling out a background check form I realized I have moved ten times in the last ten years across three different countries.

Do you publish?

Did you sign up for an ORCID ID yet?

ORCID is a non-profit organization that provides free, persistent author identifiers to distinguish individuals from other researchers and links their manuscripts, grants, and professional activities. Having an ID can differentiate people with common names and aggregate publications when name variations have occurred, such as publishing under different names.

Many publishers, funders and professional organizations are requiring OR-CID IDs so sign up for yours today! http://orcid.org/

Did you know....???

Have you ever used the Clipboard feature in PubMed? This tool allows you to send a list of selected citations to a temporary holding location. It can be very helpful when doing several searches and choosing only the items of interest. Simply check the box to the left of the citation(s) you'd like, select Clipboard from the "Send to" option in the upper right, and add to Clipboard. A link to the Clipboard will appear next to "Send to." As you continue searching, PubMed will indicate which citations you have already saved. See this in action: https://www.nlm.nih.gov/bsd/disted/pubmedtutorial/030_220.html When you are done, the list can emailed, printed, or moved to reference management software or a more permanent holding area such as MyNCBI. Items are cleared from the Clipboard after eight hours.

Remember, when using PubMed, always access PubMed from the library website, even if you are off campus. This allows you access to the thousands of articles paid for by Penn State.






