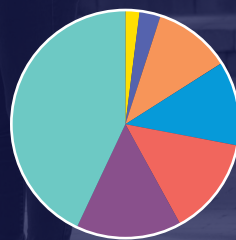

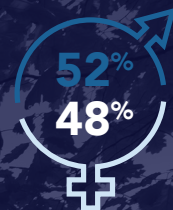
UNDERGRADUATE BACCALAUREATE STUDENT POPULATION (2019-2020)

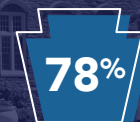

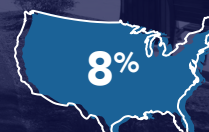

Tuition and Fees

- ▶ **PA Residents:** \$14,532
- ▶ **Out of State:** \$23,720

Housing (at Lions Gate)

- ▶ **Double-occupancy bedroom (4- or 6-person suite):** \$8,420

Our financial aid staff can help you identify and apply for a variety of grants, loans, work-study and campus employment programs, and scholarships to help make your college education more affordable.

Scholarships are available to both incoming and returning students. New students accepted to Penn State Abington will automatically be considered for scholarship opportunities.

Discover Award

The Discover Award is available to students from states bordering Pennsylvania, as well as the District of Columbia and Virginia. The award ranges between \$6,000 (for first-year students and sophomores) and \$7,000 (for juniors and seniors).

Provost Award

The Provost Award, which is dedicated to Pennsylvania residents, ranges between \$5,000 (for first-year students and sophomores) and \$7,000 (for juniors and seniors).

Admission Checklist

To complete your application for review for admission, you will need to submit the following:

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

- 1 Your online application
- 2 \$65 nonrefundable application fee (we'll waive this fee if you visit!)
- 3 Self-reported academic record (SRAR)
- 4 Your official SAT/ACT scores (SAT code #2660; ACT code #3656), if you elect to submit
 - ▶ Students applying for admission for summer/fall 2021 will have the opportunity to decide whether they would like us to include SAT/ACT exam scores in the evaluation of their application
- 5 An official copy of your college records, if applicable
- 6 AP, IB, or IGCSE scores, if applicable

TRANSFER STUDENTS

- 1 Your online application
- 2 \$65 nonrefundable application fee (we'll waive this fee if you visit!)
- 3 Your official college transcript(s)
- 4 Your official high school transcript, if applicable

Timeline for Applicants

This timeline only applies to first-year students. Please contact transfer admissions concerning transfer deadlines.

SUMMER/FALL ADMISSION

- ▶ Application available: **August 1**
- ▶ Early action deadline: **November 1**
- ▶ Priority FAFSA deadline: **December 1**

SPRING ADMISSION

- ▶ Application available: **June 1**
- ▶ Priority filing deadline: **November 1**
- ▶ Application submission deadline: **November 30**

School Colors: **NAVY BLUE** AND **WHITE**



Nittany Lion: Penn State's school mascot, modeled after the mountain lions that once roamed the region; it takes its name from Mount Nittany, a local landmark near the University Park campus

Nittany Lion Paw Print:

A symbol often found on stickers and apparel representing Penn State spirit and pride



Penn Stater: A term referring to those associated with Penn State, namely its students, alumni, and athletic teams' fans

For the Glory: A phrase from Penn State's alma mater, the University's official song played at functions like graduation and athletic contests
