In Fall 2021, the campus celebrated the opening of a 20,500 sq. ft. addition to the current campus building. The new \$14.4 million, 3-story expansion, supported by PSU-LV students and many others, includes:

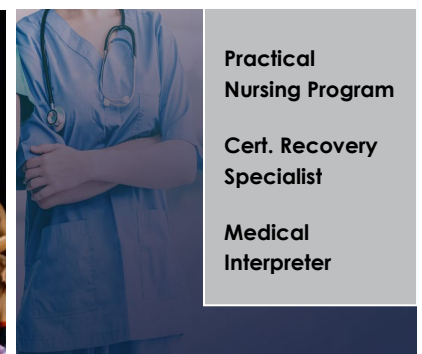
