Committee Charge and a Brief History of The Partnership

- The group's mission is:
 - To educate and support various sectors of the Centre Region as they work to change the Penn State and Community culture to reduce the high-risk behavior that can accompany the consumption of alcohol.
- The group was established in the late '90s.
 - High risk drinking was identified as a national public health problem, and the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board provided funds to form collaborative groups between communities and universities.
- In the mid-2000s, State Patty's Day was the group's primary focus.
- In 2018-19, the group expressed interest in expanding its scope beyond State Patty's Day to include other impactful events.
- The group is now being reestablished after pandemic-related interruptions.

Review of the 2022-2023 Annual Alcohol Assessment Report
