
Call for Proposals Verge: Studies in Global Asias

Verge is organizing programs that work to bridge Asian Studies, Asian American Studies, and Asian Diaspora Studies at the upcoming AAS and AAAS conferences. Our goal is to help generate and support work that straddles or otherwise navigates the differences and overlaps between Asian Studies and Asian American/Asian Diaspora Studies as intellectual formations and interdisciplines. Given Verge's editorial mission of bringing these intellectual formations into relation but not into alignment, these roundtables and panels will be designed to introduce people to the challenges and potential of conceptualizing such relationality through the paradigm of Global Asias as well as to showcase some of the innovative work that is already being done.

An important part of this mission is to identify and support scholars working on such endeavors. As such, we are putting out a **call for panel proposals** for the 2020 AAS and AAAS conferences. We will select several panel proposals to sponsor for each conference. If a panel proposal is selected, Verge will help proposers constitute panels by advertising cfps and submitting proposals for consideration. All accepted panels and roundtables will be publicized as part of Christine Yano's presidential mission of working to bridge the institutional divides segmenting the study of Asia and its diasporas and our hope is that such a concerted approach will help to create nurturing spaces and communities for like-minded scholars.

The AAS conference is scheduled for March 19-22, 2020 in Boston, MA; the AAAS conference is scheduled for April 9-11, 2020 in Washington, DC.
