Discussion Questions:

- 2. What is the role of alliteration in this poem in relation to the photograph?
- 3. Which details in this photograph are left out of the poem? What would you write in response to those details?
- 4. How is common language used to describe this photograph poetically? What does a poetic description offer that a clinical or neutral description would not?
- 5. This is an untitled painting by Cindy Sherman, who is known for "experimenting with different identities" by dressing up and photographing herself. (Gaylord, 2016) Aside from this, what do you think prompted the poem title? What title would you give a poem in response to this photograph?
